MIAMI-DADE 2014 BOATING ACCIDENTS

Miami-Dade County led the state of Florida in boating accidents in 2014, according to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission.

In 2014, a number of high-profile boat accidents made news in Miami-Dade. A Fourth of July weekend boating accident killed four people and injured a dozen more.

Another incident involved a boat driven by radio mainstay DJ Laz, according to the Miami New Times. His Voli Vodka-sponsored boat got stuck on a sandbar, and a man was killed when he got caught in the propeller while trying to free it.

Yet another highly publicized incident

involved a 39-foot 2011 Sea Vee center console with quad 300-hp Mercury Verado outboards that crashed into the Sunset Grill on a foggy evening on Feb. 23. After riding up the beach, the boat partially entered the restaurant, narrowly missing several customers.

In 2014 there were 79 boating accidents in Miami-Dade, according to the FWC. Ten people died and 47 people were injured. The number of fatalities was up from 2013, when four people died, but the number of injuries was down slightly from 50.

ACE Recreational Marine Insurance's Top Ten Recreational Boating Safety Tips for 2015

- 1. Always wear a life jacket and insist that your crew and guests do the same.
- 2. Never drink alcohol while boating.
- 3. Take a boating safety course.
- 4. Stay in control by taking charge of your safety and that of your passengers.
- 5. Put down that cellphone and stay alert.
- 6. Operate at a safe speed, and understand and obey boating safety recommendations and navigational rules.
- 7. Check the weather forecast.
- Register for a free MMSI (Maritime Mobile Service Identity) Number, and have a VHF radio equipped with Digital Selective Calling (DSC).
- 9. Use a carbon monoxide (CO) detector. CO can harm and even kill you inside or on the deck of your boat.
- 10. File a float plan.

Remember, you can have your vessel checked for safety – for free!

Dear Boat Owner:

During hurricane season we get many inquiries related to requests from insurance companies to owners about the security of Marina Bay during a hurricane and our plan to protect your vessel. The short answer is that the owner of the vessel is responsible for preparing and securing that vessel in the event of a storm. Enclosed with this letter is information we have provided to assist you in your planning and preparation for hurricane season.

Marina Bay Marina does have advantages over some other marinas which may help in your preparation of a plan to submit to the insurance company.

- Marina Bay is 4.2 miles up the New River from the Intracoastal Waterway providing it with a natural barrier from storm surge.
- The surrounding apartment complex provides additional wind barrier along with the 195 bridge.
- The staff at Marina Bay is trained in our procedures for storm preparation and attends training exercises. Each person has specific duties related to the issuance of a Hurricane Watch and or a Hurricane Warning.
- Marina Bay has done extensive wind load engineering research providing data for the design of our docks and mooring system.
- Marina Bay is well prepared with an inventory of supplies, gear and equipment for before, during and after the storm.

We at Marina Bay Marina are here to assist but please remember that the responsibility and liability for your boat are that of the boat owner.
